Description: Massachusetts native Ginny Povall purchased Stellenbosch's Protea Heights farm in 2008, after a corporate career in New York. Since that time, Big Flower (her estate grown label) and Botanica (made from grapes sourced from some of South Africa's most sought-after emerging wine regions and best growers) have rapidly become icons of the new wave of South African winemaking.

Wine Notes - 2016 Botanica Arboretum Red Blend

The 2016 Botanica Arboretum is the third vintage of Ginny Povall's Bordeaux-style red blend made from grapes grown on her own Protea Heights Farm in Stellenbosch. It is a worthy follow up to the enormously successful 2014 and 2015 bottlings from this emerging superstar. Like its predecessors, the wine is a selection, with the best barrels from the estate's fruit going in to the final blend. The wine features a nose of tobacco, blackberry and cherry, pure, focused flavors of plum and cassis, a medium body, firm tannins and exquisite balance, with an almost Medoc-like personality.
