Wine Notes - 2020 Chante Cigale Cicada Blanc

Domaine Chante Cigale's Cicada is the estate's entry-level offering and is a lovely, accessible and aromatic southern French white blend. The name pays homage to the ubiquitous singing cicadas of Provence. The grapes for this unique blend are sourced partially from plots of land owned by the Favier family in the Vaucluse, close to the estate's Chateauneuf-du-Pape home, with the Viognier coming from the Northern Rhone. This fruit-driven gem is a great daily drinker and is the perfect antidote to a constant stream of homogeneous international varietal whites. The juice is entirely fermented in stainless steel in order to maintain freshness and the nose features notes of white flowers and lime with a broad and balanced mouthfeel leading to an aromatic and fresh, bright finish.
