Description: One of South Africa's oldest wineries, Morgenster traces its history to the early 18th century. The estate was purchased in 1992 by Italian fashion magnate Giulio Bertrand who upgraded the property extensively. In addition, since 1994, Pierre Lurton of Bordeaux's Chateau Cheval Blanc, has acted as consultant and has helped produce a string of exceptional and acclaimed wines. The estate is now owned and operated by Giulio's family.

Wine Notes – 2021 Morgenster Sauvignon Blanc

Morgenster's Sauvignon Blanc is an elegant and exciting single varietal bottling offering superb quality for the price. Using ripe grapes sourced from some of the top white vineyards in Stellenbosch's Helderberg district, this hand-harvested, unwooded wine is a light yellow-green color and offers a balanced and poised profile of intense tropical fruits, good structure and moderate acidity. Vibrant notes of peppers are accompanied by the tropical tang of pineapple and mango peel. A lingering acidity gives way to beautiful balance and roundness, making this the perfect do-it-all Sauv Blanc.
