Description: In 2002, Polish-born Paul Lato left a successful career as a sommelier to pursue his dream of becoming a winemaker. With help from a number of California's top winemakers, his initial production totaled just 500 cases. In the years since, Lato has cemented a reputation as one of California's top winemakers – his wines are routinely showered with exceptional critical ratings and sell-out via mailing list.

Wine Notes – 2018 Paul Lato Le Souvenir Sierra Madre Vineyard Chardonnay

Paul Lato's story is as exceptional as his wines. Born in Poland, Lato was a successful sommelier in Toronto but harbored a dream of becoming a winemaker. After stints working for Jim Clendenen (proprietor of California Pinot pioneer Au Bon Climat) and as a cellar-rat at Bien Nacido, Lato began making his own wines in 2002. Fast forward two decades, a chance meeting with Robert Parker and fortuitously-timed help from Thomas Keller and Paul Lato Winery is now widely considered one of California's top producers of Burgundian and Rhone varietals, with a trove of critical accolades. Souvenir Chardonnay comes from the Sierra Madre Vineyard in the Santa Maria AVA. The combination of this special site and Paul's extraordinary skill create a superb, expressive, classically-styled Chardonnay that routinely enjoys mid- to high-90s critical scores from top reviewers.

The 2018 Chardonnay Le Souvenir Sierra Madre Vineyard comes from a site outside of Santa Maria and was brought up in 60% new French oak. Awesome notes of white flowers, white currants, toasted spices, honeysuckle and a touch of spice all emerge from this ultra-classic, medium to full-bodied, seamless beauty. It does everything right and is just a classy effort.

The 2018 Chardonnay Le Souvenir Sierra Madre Vineyard is one of the most expressive wines in this range. Bright and lifted, with striking aromatic intensity and all the tropical accents that are typical of this site, the 2018 is impeccably balanced from start to finish. Lemon confit, white flowers, mint and lightly honeyed notes all grace this wonderfully inviting Chardonnay from Paul Lato. In a word: superb.
