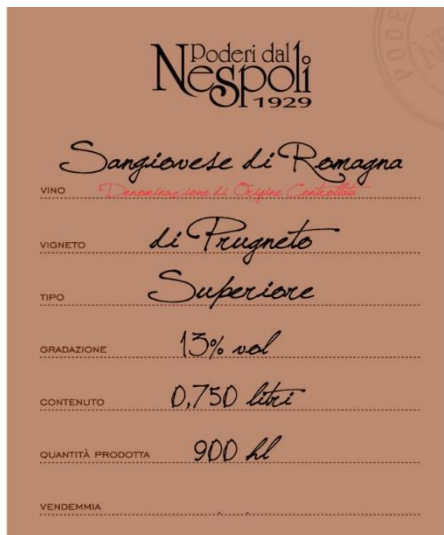
Poderi dal Nespoli Background

Description: Poderi dal Nespoli is situated in the Bidente Valley of Emilia-Romagna in central Italy. Currently run by the fourth generation of the Ravaioli family, in partnership with the Mondodelvino Group, the estate boasts state-of-the-art wine-making facilities, vineyards and cellars. The winery offers an extensive array of beautifully made wines from both native Romagnole and international varietals and enjoys distribution in 30 countries worldwide.



Wine Notes – 2019 Poderi Dal Nespoli Prugneto

Poderi Dal Nespoli's Prugneto is a single vineyard 100% Sangiovese wine sourced from the first vineyard purchased by the Ravaioli family and is one of the winery's flagship bottlings. The vineyard is located in the Bidente Valley and features clay soils.

Prugneto is a pure expression of Sangiovese di Romagna, with the varietal's trademark bright ruby color. The nose offers an intense bouquet of flowers and red and black fruit notes, while the generous mouth features flavors of violet, cherry and plums framed by soft tannins and a noteworthy freshness. Aged partially in 25 hectoliter French oak barrels to enhance complexity and structure, this beautiful wine has garnered a host of accolades and awards, including Gold Medals at wine festivals in Vienna, Zurich and from Mundus Vini.
